Using our imagination and creativity to alter story endings-let's be creative!</p>	<p>They will find out about nocturnal animals and how they find food when it is dark.</p> <p>They will find out about people who work at night and the different jobs that people do when we are asleep.</p> <p>They will discuss bedtime routines and the importance of a good night's sleep.</p> <p>They will explore the night sky and find out about the moon and stars</p>	<p><b>Understanding The World</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Exploring the world around us at night, compared to day - finding out about the people that work whilst we are asleep</li> <li>Finding out about nocturnal animals and their habitats, how they survive and find food</li> <li>Exploring why night time is dark and finding out about the moon, sun and stars and how they affect earth</li> <li>Making winter bird food and thinking about why it is important to care for animals</li> </ul>
<p><b>Expressive Arts &amp; Design</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Observing artwork from famous artists, such as Andy Goldsworthy, and copying some of their techniques</li> <li>Creating themed art, using different skills and techniques, including using unusual materials such as ice!</li> <li>Drawing club-I wonder?
