Tuesday 17th pm: Year 3-6 choir to Homebredy to sing carols

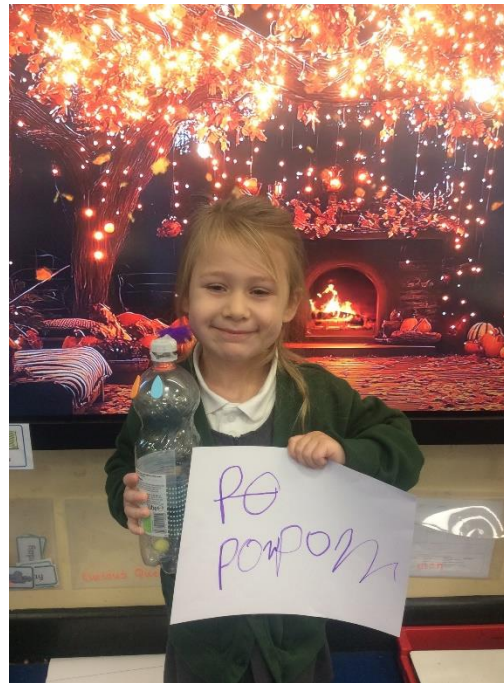
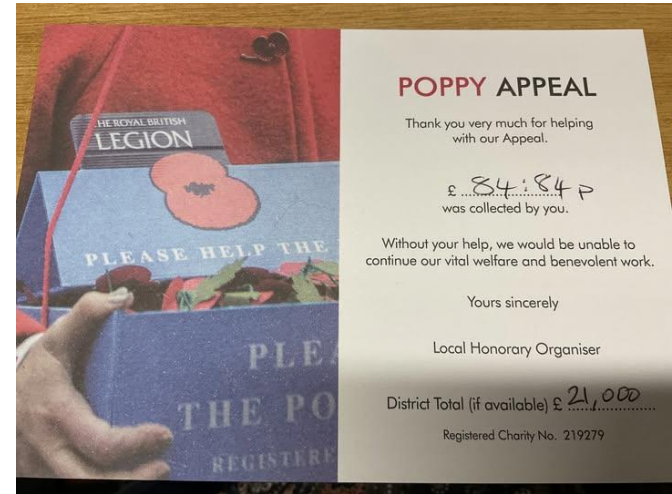
Wednesday 18th Allington Parents invited to hear songs and poems
